## CANDIDATE WITHDRAWAL DATES (I.C. 34-717)

Primary Election Deadline: March 25, 2022\*  
General Election Deadline: September 7, 2022\*  
*\*All deadlines are at 5:00 PM Local Time*

**Deadlines for withdrawal:** A candidate may not withdraw later than forty-five (45) days before an election, except in the case of a primary election, when the deadline shall be no later than the eighth Friday preceding the primary election, or a general election, when the deadline shall be no later than September 7. (I.C. 34-717(1))

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

**Eligibility for appointment:** Any candidate who has filed a statement of withdrawal pursuant to this section shall not be allowed to be appointed to fill a vacancy unless such vacancy occurs because of the death of a previous candidate. (I.C. 34-717(2))

Please contact the Secretary of State's Office or your County Clerk if you have any questions.

Once filed, a declaration of candidacy may not be altered. If the candidate decides during the filing period to change the declaration of candidacy, the candidate must first withdraw and then re-file.

**Note: Filing fees are nonrefundable**
