SORREL TO JOHNS LANDING

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Bloom Street project will improve pedestrian facilities and will not involve rebuilding the roadway.

- Construct curb, gutter and sidewalk on the north side of Bloom Street to match existing sidewalk to the east and west
- Extend curb, gutter and sidewalk on the west side of Collister between Bloom St. and John's Landing St. to match existing sidewalk to the north and south
- Extend curb, gutter and sidewalk on the south side of John's Landing from Collister and tie into existing sidewalk on the west side of the Maplewood bridge
- Update/replace existing pedestrian ramps
- Install stormwater facilities
- Minor irrigation work

Sidewalk construction to start mid-August

The Ada County Highway District (ACHD) is pleased to announce that construction on the Bloom Street Project will begin on or about August 16th. The project is anticipated to be complete in October.

Construction Impacts

During construction it is anticipated that Bloom, Collister and John's Landing will remain open to traffic. However, traffic may be restricted at times to one lane with flaggers.

Work will occur during day time hours from approximately 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. and may include the following impacts: general construction noise, dust, temporary lane restrictions, equipment safety backup alarms, and ground vibration.

Once the new concrete curb and gutter have been poured and once again after the sidewalk is poured, we ask that residents not use the new concrete for at least four days.
