### Note

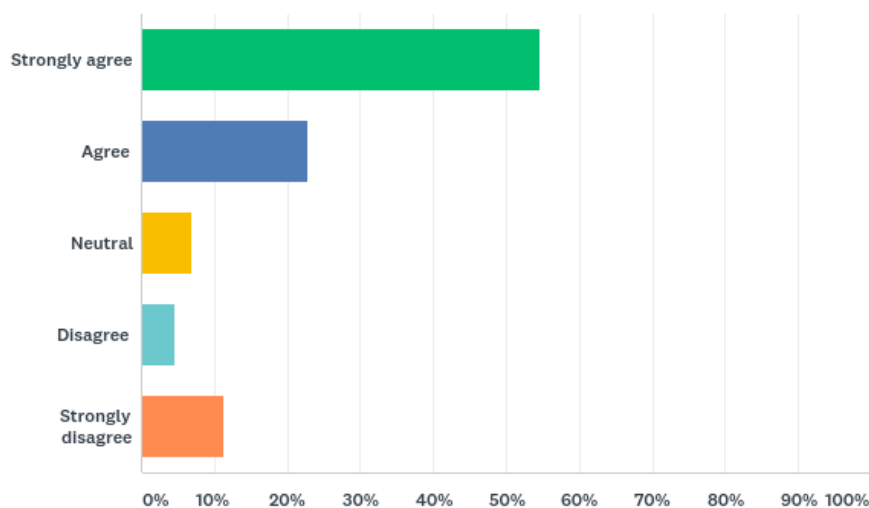
The postcard included an error indicating that the roadway would be built narrower than it exists today. While residents were not in support of narrowing the roadway, they were in support of adding sidewalks.

- 3 people remain neutral

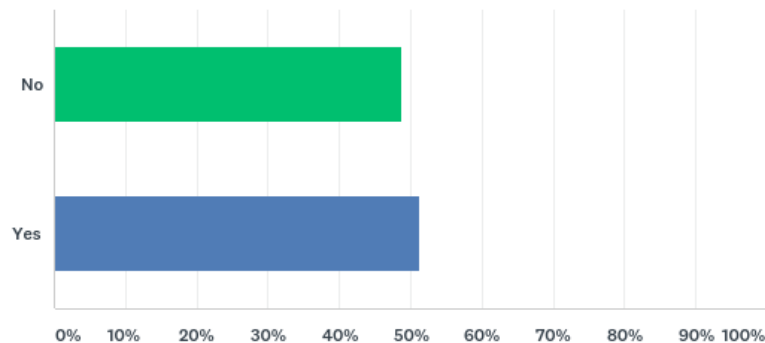
*Typical comments*

- **22 people indicated there was something additional we needed to account for**
- 21 did not think there was anything else we needed to consider

*Typical comments*

- Many who indicated there was something additional we needed to account for mentioned their dislike of narrowing the street. Please see note at beginning of summary.
- Desire for a bike lane
- Requests for street lights and slowing traffic
- Concerns about construction
- Concerns about losing property in front of home, which would not allow for parking car in driveway
