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Study Area



Study Purpose and Objectives

- Develop a preferred concept-level design of Orchard Street as a Mobility Arterial between Gowen Road and Victory Road
- Complete a NEPA-compliant analysis of roadway design alternatives



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Corridor and Study Components

- Level 3 bicycle facility as identified in ACHD Bike Master Plan
- Pedestrian facilities
- Compare roundabout and signal options at Orchard/Gowen intersection
- Balance access, traffic flow, and safety
- Maintain and improve local roadway connections



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Planning Basemap Development

- Property ownership and existing use/access
- Utilities
- Environmental resources
- Drainage
- Soils/Geotechnical



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Traffic Evaluation

- Current traffic counts
- Traffic forecasts
 - COMPASS Model
- Peak hour traffic analysis for capacity needs



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Environmental Scan

- Environmental resources for basemap
- Secondary source information and previous studies
- Coordination and consultation to determine necessary agency permitting



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Alternative Design Concepts

- Identify and sketch **Initial Options**
- **Screen** *Initial Options*
- Develop **Alternative Conceptual Designs**
 - Horizontal alignment (slight differences)
 - Intersection types
 - Roadway network connectivity/access schemes
 - Bicycle and pedestrian facilities
- Refine *Alternative Conceptual Designs* based on further evaluation and Stakeholder and Public feedback
