INVITATION TO BID 2022 Maintenance Rock Crushing MD-1733

Sealed bids for 2022 Maintenance Rock Crushing will be received at the offices of the Ada County Highway District (ACHD), 3775 Adams Street, Garden City, Idaho, 83714, until 3:00 p.m. (local time) Wednesday, October 20, 2021, at which time the bids will be publicly opened.

In accordance with the specifications, the scope of work shall consist of crushing rock to produce approximately 15,000 tons of 1/4-inch Chip Seal Aggregate Material and approximately 27,000 tons of 3/8-inch Chip Seal and Pit Run Aggregate. This scope of work includes the provision of all labor and equipment necessary to produce the crushed aggregate quantity required.

Complete production and delivery of all crushed aggregate shall be on or before September 30, 2022. This completion date is predicated on the intent of ACHD to issue a "Notice to Proceed" to the Contractor on or about January 10, 2022. ACHD shall be entitled to "Liquidated Damages" of \$500.00 for each calendar day of delay in the completion of the work.

All prospective respondents are strongly encouraged to attend a Pre-Submission Meeting and Proposal Workshop at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, October 13, 2021. As part of the Pre-Bid Meeting, a Site Visit of the Schmidt Pit will be conducted. Prospective bidders will meet at the Schmidt Pit located one mile west of Pleasant Valley Road on Ten Mile Creek Road. Although participation in the Pre-Submission Meeting and Site Visit is voluntary, prospective respondents are encouraged to attend as it will be the only opportunity, aside from written inquiry and or clarification requests, to obtain important information concerning this procurement. **This is also the ONLY time a Site Visit will be conducted.**

All questions or clarifications concerning this Invitation to Bid or the content and requirements of the Bid and Contract Documents must be submitted and received in writing by 4:30 p.m. on October 13, 2021. ACHD will respond to questions and clarification requests requiring an addendum via a Final Addenda issued to all Bid Holders on or before 4:30 p.m. on October 14, 2021.

ACHD has prepared the Contract Documents and Proposal Documents for Submittal. In addition, Contract Documents may be obtained by sending an email to procurements@achdidaho.org. ACHD offices are open Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Electronic copies of the documents may be obtained from www.demadstar.com.

The apparent low-cost Bidder will be required to furnish the necessary additional bond(s) for the faithful performance of the contract and supply the necessary insurance documents as prescribed in the Contract Documents.


Proposals must be accompanied by an Original Bid Security in an amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount of the proposal submitted. The Bid Security may be in the form of an original certified check, cashier's check, or a bid bond issued by a surety authorized to issue such bonds in the State of Idaho. Any Contractor submitting a certified check or cashier's check for bid guarantee will be required to submit with the proposal a letter from his bonding company stating that it will guarantee bonding for the Contractor, in the event said Contractor is awarded the contract. Said letter is to be included with the Proposal Documents for Submittal, and shall name the Contractor, Project Number, and the amount of bonding value being guaranteed. The successful bidder will be required to furnish the necessary additional bond(s) for the faithful performance of the contract and supply the required insurance documents. As a Service Contract, no Public Works License is required.

ACHD reserves the right to reject all proposals or reject any proposal not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents whenever such action appears to be in the best interest of ACHD. Award of a contract pursuant to this procurement may be delayed, without penalty, for up to sixty (60) calendar days after the date of bid.

Expected Contract Bonding Requirement including alternates: Less than \$1,150,000.00
