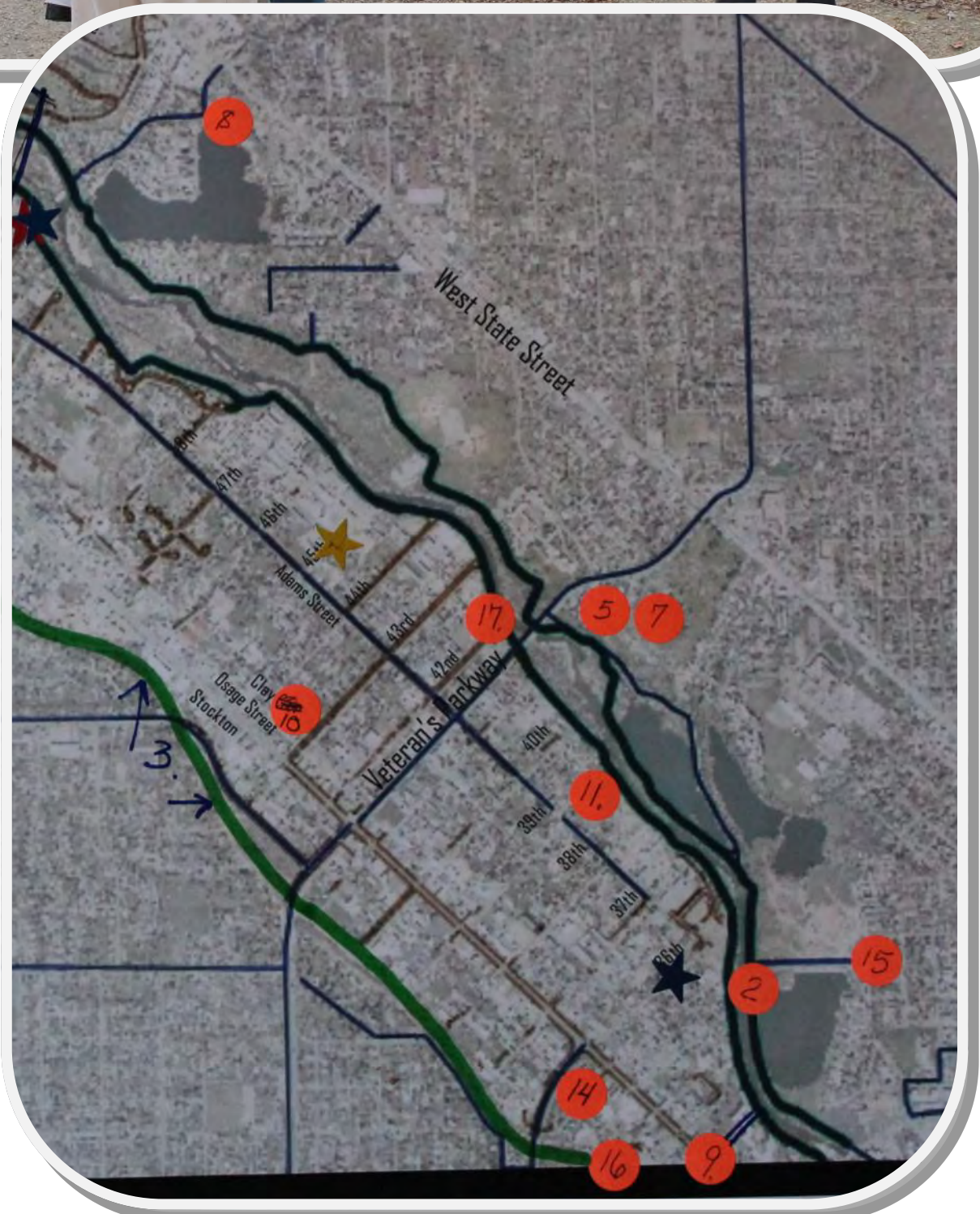
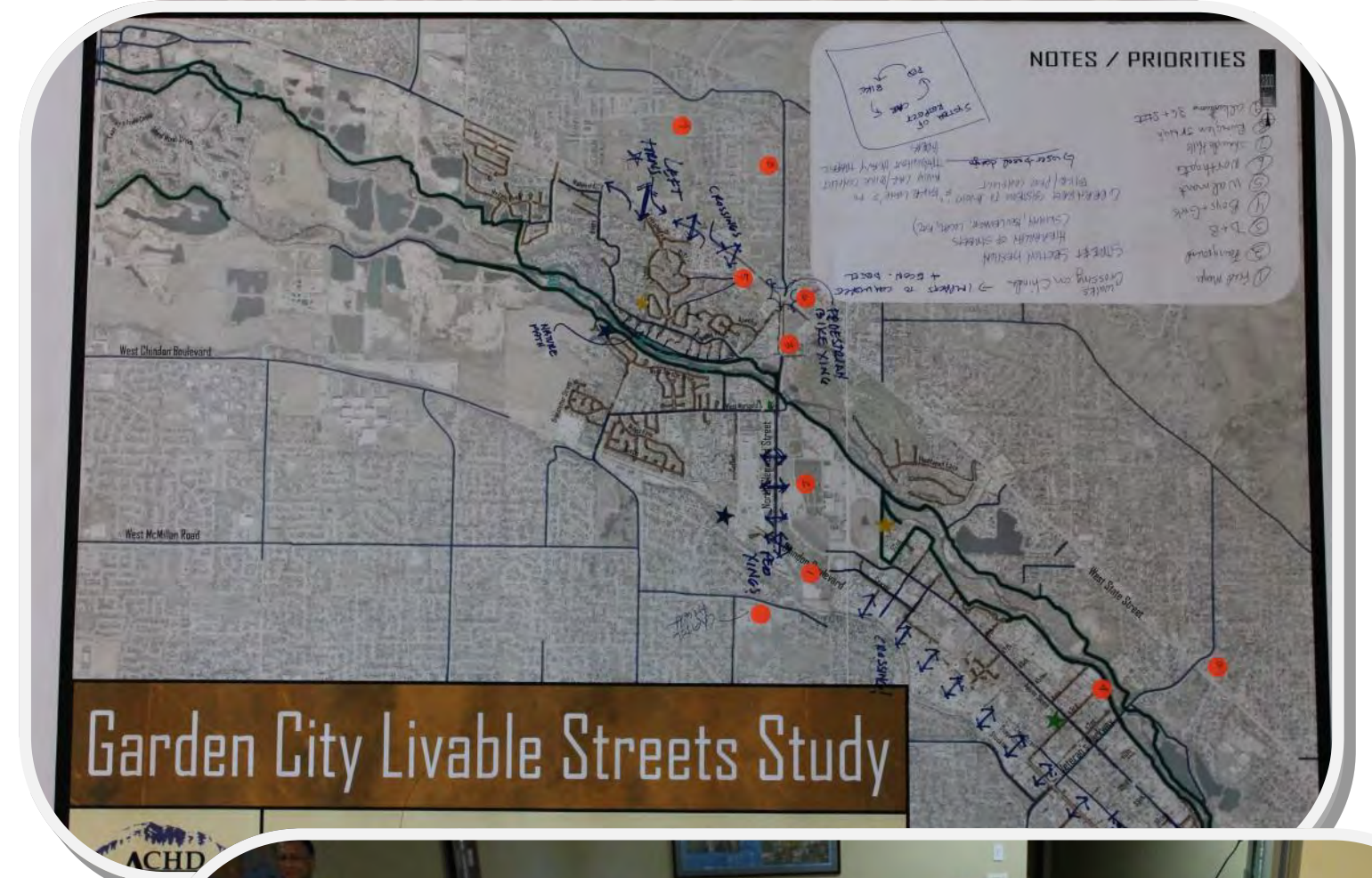


### November 8, 2012 Workshops: What we heard

- ⇒ We are in Garden City. There should be gardens.
- ⇒ A new Main Street should have: trees, attractive areas, on-street parking, vibrancy, people, and outdoor eating spaces.
- ⇒ Careful consideration needed for building frontage, stormwater management and utility placement.
- ⇒ Improve street connectivity.
- ⇒ Complete the streets in Old Town as well as along Garrett Street, Arney Lane and Coffey Street.



- ⇒ Improve traffic flow on major roads within Garden City.
- ⇒ Optimize community activity sites through improved walking and bicycling connections.
- ⇒ Install or upgrade pedestrian crossings on Chinden Boulevard and Glenwood Street.
- ⇒ Integrate the budding artist and micro-brewery culture in Garden City with street improvements and land use approval.
- ⇒ Pursue upgrades to the Greenbelt gateways and install wayfinding to/from the Greenbelt.
