



Roundabout center

ACHD and the City of Boise are working together to determine what will go inside the roundabout.

Constraints

There are several factors that must be considered when deciding what to put in the center:

- **Sight distance** - Vertical treatments are necessary to increase visibility of the intersection, promote lower speeds, and break the headlight glare of oncoming vehicles. However, treatments must permit adequate intersection and stopping sight distance.
- **Intersection is in a floodplain** – Treatments cannot restrict or redirect floodwater in case of a major flood.
- **Funding** – Typically, ACHD is not legally able to pay for landscaping.
- **Maintenance** – If landscaped, we must determine how maintenance will be paid for.
