Ada County Highway District

The Ada County Highway District (ACHD) is starting preliminary work on a concept design for the Linder Road and Deer Flat Road intersection area, a neighborhood that features a sports park, several schools, and a variety of businesses.

The goal of the concept is to engage the community and determine what type of intersection will efficiently and safely meet the future needs of all users – motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists. We are in the very initial stages, which means that we don't have a design, nor have we chosen an alternative at this time. Please review this newsletter to learn more!


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Develop and evaluate intersection alternatives.

Alternatives could include:



Traditional signalized intersection



Roundabout

A "No Build" alternative will also be considered.



Include pedestrian and bicycle facilities at the intersection. Fill in the sidewalk gaps on Linder and Deer Flat roads in the vicinity of the intersection.

PROJECT PURPOSE



Improve safety! Since 2008 there have been more than two dozen accidents at this intersection.



Improve pedestrian connectivity.



Increase capacity.

HOW DOES THE PROCESS WORK?

- As part of the federal aid process ACHD is required to develop and rank several intersection alternatives for consideration.
- Using feedback from the public survey and technical data, a list of screening criteria will be developed.
- Each alternative will be ranked based on this criteria.
- A recommended preferred alternative will be presented to residents at a public involvement meeting this fall for public input.

PROJECT TIME LINE

Spring 2014 ---→ Evaluate existing conditions
Summer 2014 ---→ Project survey* ♠ We are here!

Fall 2014 ---- Develop and evaluate alternatives; Public

involvement meeting*

Spring 2015 ---→ Complete concept design
As early as 2016+ Right-of-way acquisition

PD⁺⁺ ---→ Construction

*Public involvement opportunity. *Dependent upon federal funds and programming. ** Subject to Commission approval. Preliminary Development is a phase which ACHD may spend money on a project that still has no construction year.
