
# ALTERNATIVES BEING CONSIDERED

### Quadrant Intersection




All of the left turns are removed from the Glenwood Street/State Street intersection and rerouted to occur as right turns and left turns via four signalized intersections.

• Why? Removing left turns from the intersection improves operations and safety

## Displaced Left Turn (Continuous Flow Intersection)



One or more of the left-turns are moved to the other side of the opposing through traffic at the Glenwood Street/State Street intersection.

 Why? Left-turns proceed at the same time as the through movements resulting in improved operations and safety
