*Thank you for attending tonight's open house. The purpose of the meeting is to give you an opportunity to review the proposed design and give us your input.*

## Project Description

Reconstruct the intersection to include:

- Additional vehicle travel lanes
- Additional left and right turn lanes
- Curb, gutter, and sidewalk on the Five Mile Road approaches
- Curb, gutter, and multi-use pathways for pedestrians and cyclists on the Lake Hazel Road approaches
- Buffered bike lanes on Five Mile Road and pathways on Lake Hazel Road for bicycle mobility
- Raised curb to manage access to improve safety and mobility

**The intersection will be designed to allow for U-Turns.**
