- a. **IFYWP Initial Draft** (Rebecca P.)- Initial draft has just been released. Public Partner Agencies, Plan Timeline and Highlights were presented to committee. Currently ACHD is in second round of public outreach through Aug. 14<sup>th</sup>. Adoption on Sept. 25<sup>th</sup>.
  - b. Boise Fatality Task Review (Cpl. Kyle W.) Started by explaining the Task Force and its members, describing committee members. This Task Force is in response to 2023 as a deadly year in Ada County for pedestrians and bicyclists. The committee analyzes crash locations, reads and discusses every crash report, and make recommendations for reducing future crashes.

Wills' analysis of 2024 data - One crash of two pedestrians struck by a motorist on Main St. involved poor behavior (aka speeding) which is prevalent in downtown on weekends. In Boise city, continuing trend upward of bike/ped crashes. In 2023 – 13 Serious Injuries of peds and 8 fatalities. More than half in downtown core. Same year – 12 Serious Injuries and 1 fatal for bicyclists. Near misses are not recorded. BPD looks at the cause of these crashes. Distracted drivers need to be addressed. Identify high crash/high fatality locations. 6<sup>th</sup>/Front has been a bad location for bad motor vehicle behavior. High speeds, reckless behavior. Boise Police Dept has a form on its website to submit traffic concerns. Goes directly to Corporal Wills. https://www.cityofboise.org/departments/police/report-a-crime/traffic-enforcement/.

Finally, Corporal Wills has seen that more severe consequence for an action demonstrate more compliance.
